Exam Exemption Challenge!

We want to reward students who have exemplary attendance. Students who have less than 3 absences and 3 tardies will be able to opt out of exams or take them on a “help, not hurt” basis.

Criteria:

1. A student may not have more than 3 days of absences per semester, (excused or unexcused), 4 is too many!
2. A student may not have more than 3 unexcused tardies, 4 is too many.
3. A student must maintain a “B” or better in each quarter during the semester.
4. All exemptions must be signed by the teacher and parent.
5. A student who qualifies for this program can take the exam on a “help, not hurt basis”. This means, if you do poorly on that exam, it won’t hurt your grade.
6. AP classes are not exempt and students will have to take those tests.
